Vin and Frank: For your approval:

*The Department of Environmental Control contacted the Town of Babylon Department of Public Works (DPW) Engineering Division regarding any drainage issues on 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Wyandanch, NY. DPW was not aware of any recurrent flooding issues on North 28<sup>th</sup> Street. It is possible that during the August 19 and 20<sup>th</sup> 2024 "Super" rainstorm, water may have accumulated after this historic event. In September/October 2024, the up gradient drainage system, a series of recharge basins and drainage infrastructure underwent significant maintenance which would improve its capacity. In any case the developer will be providing substantial drainage to Town of Babylon Planning Board Specification requirements for the site in the form of a drainage collection system, drainage structures and the recharge basin. The plans are reviewed by the Town to, at minimum, meet these requirements. Stormwater runoff will not be discharged off the site on to N. 28<sup>th</sup> Street from this development.*
